David Donaldson, Stephen Roche, Janet Roddick

Wellington based composers David Donaldson, Janet Roddick and Steve Roche, have composed music for a remarkable array of film, television, theatrical and installation projects since 1995. Plan 9 has created the original music for over 30 feature films.

They won the 2021 SOUNZ Contemporary Award at the APRA Silver Scrolls for their album *The Bewilderness* a work for altered string quartet with 2 voices they released in 2021. This year they collaborated with musicians around the Pacific to create the score for Katherine McRae's award-winning documentary *Pacific Mother*. They have completed work on a 6 part TV drama.

Their score for *They Shall Not Grow Old* (dir Peter Jackson) was a nominee for the 2019 Critics Choice Documentary Awards. They have won Best Score 3 times at the NZ Film & Television Awards for *Predicament*, *Saving Grace* and *Jack Brown Genius*. They were finalists at the APRA Series Awards for *Life Force* and were NZ Film & Television Awards finalists for *Jubilee* & *Perfect Strangers* (film), *Forgotten Silver* (tv) and *Earthquake* (tv).

While *The Lord Of The Rings: Rings Of Power* was being made in NZ Plan 9 and David Long created 8 music compositions for the production to use. Their song *This Wandering Day*, with lyrics by JD Payne, was sung in episode 5 by actor Megan Richards playing Harfoot character Poppy. A version sung by Janet and produced by Bear McCreary plays over the end credits.

Geoff Dixon: Portraits Of Us premiered at the 2022 NZ Film Festival. Last year they scored TVNZ's Our Big Blue Backyard S3, having done the 2 previous series. They composed the music for Linda Niccol's Poppy released in May 2021. In 2020 Plan 9 created the score for The Tender Trap (Greenstone Pictures) directed by Sima Urale and provided music for Go Further South – 12 hours of slow tv and scored Kerry Fox's first short film Topping Out. They scored 3 part series Volcanic New Zealand and Modern Dinosaurs for Discovery UK/NZ. Plan 9 composed scores to 2 flagship Animal Planet features – Living With Maneaters & Mysterious Wilds of India.

Included in their 30+ feature films are Annie Goldson's documentary *Kim Dotcom: Caught In The Web* (2017), *Kobi* (2017) by Andrea Bosshard, *The Man In The Hat* by Luit Beiringa and Gaylene Preston's documentary on Rita Angus. Other highlights are *The Great Maiden's Blush* (2016) and *What We Do In The Shadows* (2014) by Taika Waititi and Jemaine Clement. They did the music for the stunning feature documentary *Antarctica: A Year On Ice*. In 2014 they scored a Japanese/French/ Discovery co-pro 6 x 1 hour doco series called *Life Force 2* (aka *Mutant Planet 2*) which won a Gold World Medal at the New York Festivals' International TV & Film Awards. Their theme for RNZ's Morning Report played from 2014 to 2022.

With Long they co-wrote the song *Misty Mountains* for *The Hobbit*: An *Unexpected Journey* and this theme was used by Howard Shore as part of the score. Also with Long, they wrote cultural music and created musical sound design for *The Lord Of The Rings* Trilogy and *King Kong* and their music was used in *The Lovely Bones*.

Plan 9 have been providing music editorial services since the early days of the *Lord of the Rings* animatics for Peter Jackson. They've done music editing and temp score editing on numerous films and tv series for NZ and international projects.
